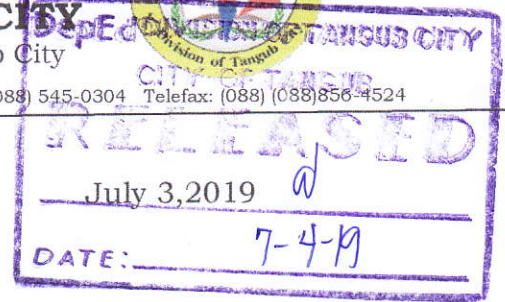

**CREATION OF SCHOOL DENGUE TASK FORCE FOR THE**  
*Dengue Program*

To : **District In charge**  
**School Administrators / Teacher In Charge**  
**Public Elementary Schools**

1. Dengue is an ongoing public health concern in the Philippines. Most cases were noted from the 5 to 14 years age group. The Dengue has become a year-round threat in the Philippines, which occurs throughout the year but it is especially rampant during the rainy seasons and with a peak in cases from July to November each year, one to two months after the start of rainy season
2. With this alarming situation and the commitment of the Department of Education to address the dengue virus and to promote and provide a safer and healthier learning environment for Filipino learners, it is enjoined Creation of Dengue Task Force shall be implemented in school populace. This is to promote dengue preventive and control measures throughout the schools.
3. To emphasize the urgency of the anti -dengue drive through the **4S Strategy**- which stands for **Search and destroy, Seek early consultation, Self-protection measures**, and **Say "no" to indiscriminate fogging**.
4. In this regard, all Elementary and Secondary schools are hereby directed to submit the members of their School Dengue Task Force and their plan of activities on or before July 31, 2019 at Division Health and Nutrition Section.
