CONDUCT OF THE 2019 DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (DSPC) INDIVIDUAL WRITING CONTEST CUM ENHANCEMENT TRAINING FOR RSPC QUALIFIERS

This Division

- 1. The Division of Tangub City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) announces the conduct of the 2018 Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) with the theme "Embracing ASEAN Integration: Campus Journalists' Role in Inclusive Education" on July 24-26, 2019 to be hosted by St. Michael's High School, Tangub City.
- 2. This conference/activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. demonstrate understanding on the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for learners' interest in pursuing journalism as a career;
 - c. promote responsible journalism and fair ethical use of social media; and
 - d. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competition and training.
- 3. The two-day DSPC shall include nine (9) Individual Writing Contests in newswriting, feature writing, editorial writing, sports writing, copy reading and headline writing, cartooning, photojournalism, science and health and column writing. Group contests like radio broadcasting, TV broadcasting, collaborative desktop publishing, online writing and contest on school papering shall be conducted sometimes in August 2019.
- 4. The third day (July 26) of this activity is scheduled for the one-day enhancement training for the identified Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) qualifiers.

- 5. Participants of this conference/activity are the first place winners in the school level individual writing contest together with their school paper advisers/coaches in both elementary and secondary schools.
- 6. Senior High School students can join in the contest with the Junior High School students-participants under secondary level category.
- 7. Advisers and coaches are responsible for the contestants' safety and security all throughout the three-day DSPC. Thus, parents' consent, medical certificate and Registration Form/Participant's Profile must be prepared, filled out and submitted in bunch before the day of the conduct of the DSPC to the Registration/Attendance Committee (Attention: EPS Gina L. Mandawe, Committee Chairman) or upon arrival on Day 1 at the contest venue.
- 8. It is expected that every participating school shall bring one hard copy of the school publication/school paper (12 to 16 pages in A4 size separating English from Filipino) as mandatory requirement in joining the contests.
- 9. Photojournalism contestants shall bring digital camera (16-20 megapixels) with fresh/fully-charged battery and empty SD card for photo walk and laptop for uploading of pictures and lay-outing.
- 10. School paper advisers/coaches are encouraged to give input to their contestants on the new trends/updates on the various contest events prior to the participation of the activity.
- 11. Top seven individual writing contest winners in every event shall be proclaimed during the Awarding Ceremony in the afternoon of Day 2 but only the top three winners will qualify to the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC).
- 12. Included in this Memorandum are the following: 1) Matrix of Activities and 2) Registration Form/Participant's Profile.
- 13. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants and the Technical Working Group (TWG) to this activity shall be charged against school MOOE/school publication/local funds subject for usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations.
- 14. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is hereby enjoined.
