



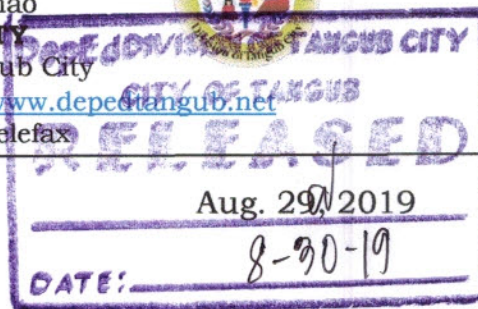

Guidelines for Division Science & Technology Fair 2019

1. This contest is open to all public and private secondary schools.
2. Participants could be from Grade 7 to Grade 12 students .
3. Each secondary school shall submit a research paper on or before Oct. 4,2019 and a poster display/display board to be displayed on the day of the search , following the National Science and Technology Fair Guidelines issued as DepEd Order (Refer to DepEd Order 134s. 2018).
4. Division Science and Technology Fair shall be conducted on Oct.11, 2019 with the following categories:

5. Top 3 winners in each category shall be chosen and declared division winners together with the adviser and shall be given recognition during the Division Science & Technology Fair and to be awarded during Tangub Rewards.
