

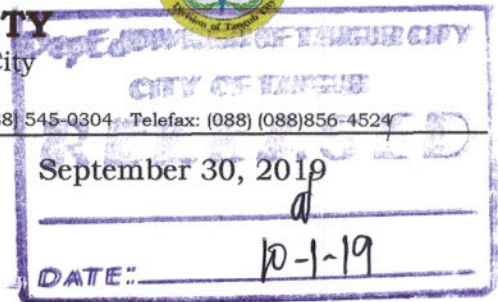

**GUIDELINES ON DIVISION SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY FAIR 2019**

1. This contest is open to all public and private secondary schools.
2. Contestants are coming from Grade 7 to Grade 12 .
3. Each secondary school shall submit 3 hard copies of the complete research paper on or before October 9,2019 following the National Science & Tech Fair Guidelines issued as DepEd Order (Refer to DepEd Order 134 s. 2018 for complete details)
4. Display board /Poster must have a 38" x 48" dimensions(portrait style) and made of paper(tarp papel) following the National Science & Tech Fair Guidelines. (Refer to DepEd Order 134 s. 2018 for complete details).Poster should be displayed in the venue before 8:30A.M.on the day of the contest.
5. Top 3 winners in each category shall be chosen and declared division winners together with the adviser and shall be given recognition during Division Science & Technology Fair.
6. The top winner for each category shall be the official entry for the Regional Science fair on November of the same year.
