ORIENTATION ON SCHOOL HEALTH DENTAL CARE PROGRAM (SHDCP)

To : **Chief, Curriculum Implementation Division (CID)**

Elementary & Secondary School Heads
This Division

1. The Department of Education, Division of Tangub City, through the Bureau of Learners Support Services (BLSS)–School Health and Nutrition Section, shall implement the School Health Dental Care Program which is a health program designed for efficient implementation that will help shape the full educational potential and well-being of the learner and DepEd personnel.
2. In this connection, the Health and Nutrition Section shall conduct a two days orientation on School Health Dental Care Program on February 7, 2020 for Batch 1 and February 21, 2020 for Batch 2 at the Division Conference Hall at 8:00AM to 5:00 in the afternoon.
3. The objectives of this orientation are to:
 1. increase public/ school populace awareness on the dental problems;
 2. improve oral hygiene knowledge and practices;
 3. decrease the prevalence of dental caries and other oral health problems;
 4. orient the health workers about school dental health care program.
4. The participants are: Batch 1- School Clinic Teacher/ In charged, Batch 2 - School Administrators/School Heads/ TICs both elementary and secondary school and SHN personnel. Any representation, substitution, and/or absence must be made in writing beforehand and be approved by the Schools Division Superintendent.
5. No registration fee shall be collected. Expenses for meals, snacks and training materials are covered by the SHDCP funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
