- Message should imply optimism
- Lyrics with music shall be judged as one. The composition can be composed by a single person or collectively
- The JURY will include well renowned composers headed by musical director URIAN Awardee Toto Gentica alongside noted songwriter-composers(to be announced) and the Board of Earthday Jam Foundation, Inc.
- The length should be less than 4 minutes including intros and interludes
- The composition can be in Tagalog or English
