This Division

- 1. - d. October 5 All DepED personnel and students shall participate in the flag ceremony at 7:00 a.m. whether the personnel are in the offices or on work-from-home arrangements. The students shall likewise be enjoined to participate virtually.
- 6. It is also expected that health and safety protocols, as prescribed by the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-EID) and the Department of Health (DOH) is religiously observed at all times.
