



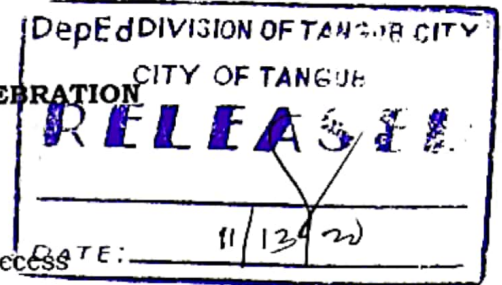

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

Enacted at Metro Manila, on May 21, the twenty-third day of May, 2019.

REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11369

AN ACT PROMOTING THE OBSERVANCE OF DOMESTIC  
 11 OF 1989 YEARS NATIONAL STUDENTS DAY

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the  
 Philippines in Congress assembled

Section 1. This Act shall be known as the National  
 Students Day Act.

Section 2. Pursuant to Article II, Section 17 of the 1987  
 Constitution, the Department of Education, the Department of  
 Education, Culture and Sports, and the Department of Education  
 shall coordinate the observance of National Students Day.

The State recognizes the value of developing a strong  
 sense of responsibility among the youth and supports the  
 observance of National Students Day which was proclaimed  
 in the National Students Day Act of 1989, to ensure that  
 the youth of the Philippines are equipped with the skills  
 and competencies necessary for the future.

Section 3. In observance of the observance of National  
 Students Day, the Department of Education, the Department  
 of Education, Culture and Sports, and the Department of  
 Education shall coordinate the observance of National  
 Students Day.

Section 4. The annual program of activities for the observance  
 of National Students Day shall be prepared and submitted to  
 the National Youth Commission (NYC) during the last week  
 of the Department of Education and the Department of  
 Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) shall coordinate the  
 annual program of activities to all public and private schools.

All schools, colleges and universities are encouraged to  
 award their NC support for services and activities performed by  
 students during the observance of National Students Day.

Section 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its  
 publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general  
 circulation.
