



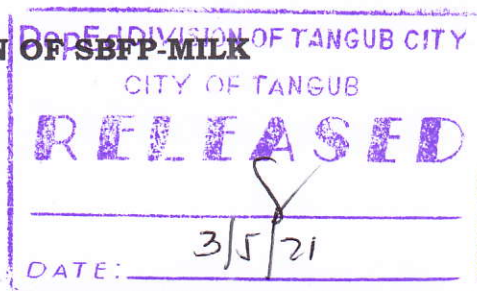

SCHEDULE OF DELIVERY AND DISTRIBUTION OF SBFP-MILK COMPONENT SY: 2020-2021

1. Pursuant to Republic Act 11037 also known as Masustansyang Pagkain para sa Batang Pilipino Act, promulgated on June 20, 2018, the National Feeding Program shall be implemented targeting all undernourished in public kindergarten and elementary schools to address undernutrition and hunger. One of the components of the National Feeding Program is the Milk Feeding Program.

2. A fresh milk shall be provided to all kindergarten learners, and the Grade 1 to Grade 6 learners who were wasted and severely wasted based on the School Year 2019-2020. Grade 6 recipients who are promoted to Grade 7 will no longer be included in the program, it will be replaced by learners who are Indigenous People (IPs), Pupils-at risk-of dropping-out(PARDOs) and those coming from indigent families, shall be considered as secondary beneficiaries.

3. In this connection, the distribution will be on following schedule date, time and number of milk allocation per day and prepare two sets of **Distribution List (Set A - 22days & Set B - 3days)**.
