



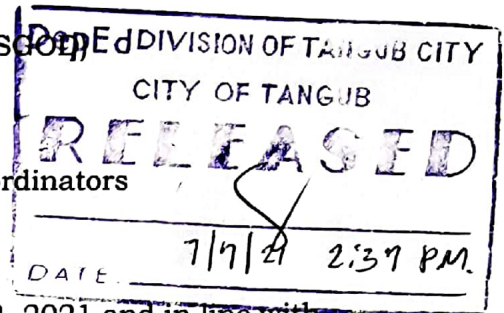



NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH 2021 Mechanics for the RESILIENCE Mobile Photography Contest

- I. **THEME.** RESILIENCE refers to Filipinos' ability to adapt and recover from hazards and emergencies. This includes various programs, activities and projects that deals with disaster prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, rehabilitation and recovery.
- II. **PARTICIPANTS.** The contest is OPEN to all High School, Senior High School and College students in Northern Mindanao. EXCEPT siblings, children or grandchildren of OCD 10 officials and employees.
- III. **DURATION.** Office of Civil Defense 10 will accept entries from 25 June to 25 July 2021.
- IV. **SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES:**
 1. Each participant is allowed to submit a maximum of ONE (1) entry only.
 2. The entry to be submitted should be an image/photo with a corresponding "photo title" and "photo caption". The caption must indicate the place where the image was taken and must have an accurate description of what the photo is about.
 3. Deadline for the submission of entries is on 25 July 2021 at 5:00 P.M. All entries with the participants' name, address and contact information should be submitted through this link <https://bit.ly/3zGbnDj>.
 4. Proof of enrolment – valid school ID may be required from participants whose entries made it to the shortlist.
 5. The contest participant is responsible for securing – prior to submission of the entry – a formal consent from concerned parties if the image contains any material or element that is not the participant's property, or if any person appears in the photo (*i.e. subjects of the photo*). OCD should not in any way – be held responsible for the contest participant's inability to secure the necessary permission or consent for their submitted entries.

V. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Photographs should be:
 - Created and taken by the contest participant.
 - Created and taken using a mobile device like smartphones and tablets.
 - In full color.
 - In LANDSCAPE orientation.
 - In mobile digital format.
 - Taken using the best settings of the mobile device.



- Photographs should NOT:
 - Contain watermarks or any identifying mark.
 - Violate person’s rights, including, but not limited to copyrights and privacy.
 - Previously submitted or won in any photography contest.
 - Contain images of elected government officials.
 - Edited or enhanced.
- Photographs should be submitted in the raw image format of the mobile device used and should reflect the file metadata or properties. OCD 10 reserves the right to reject entries taken using non-mobile devices.

VI. SCREENING OF ENTRIES:

- Criteria for Judging are as follows:

○ Adherence to the Theme	25%
○ Composition	25%
○ Photographic Quality	25%
○ Visual Impact	25%
- The Judges shall be composed of the following:
 - Chairperson : OCD 10 Representative
 - Members : DOST 10 Representative
 - : DILG 10 Representative
 - : DSWD 10 Representative
 - : NEDA 10 Representative
- The decision of the Judges shall be final.
- Announcement of winners will be posted through OCD10’s official social media pages (Civil Defense Northern Mindanao – Region 10).

VII. PRIZES

- Cash prizes are subject to government taxes and follows accounting and auditing rules. Cash prizes (after tax deductions) are as follows:

• 1 st Place	-	PHP 12,000.00
• 2 nd Place	-	PHP 8,000.00
• 3 rd Place	-	PHP 5,000.00



VIII. OTHER PROVISIONS

1. The OCD shall have exclusive property rights of the three (3) winning entries in its communications and publication materials including but not limited to OCD Official Gazettes, online publications, calendars and planners.
2. By joining the contests, all participants agree to release and discharge OCD and its officials and employees from any claims, losses or damages arising from their participation.
3. Participants agree that their names and the name of school represented may be released to the public for purposes of announcing the contest finalists and winners.
