



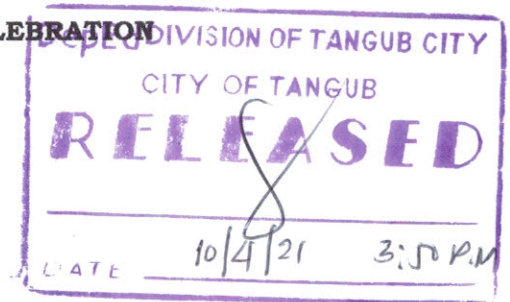



6. Expenses of this activity shall be charged to Program Support Fund subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

CONTEST GUIDELINES ON TEACHERS GOT TALENT

1. The participants are reminded to observe and follow minimum health standards such as wearing of facemasks/ face shields, regular washing of hands, using disinfectants like alcohol and sanitizers, and observing social distancing, consistent with the guidelines from Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF), Department of Health (DOH), and the Department of Education (DepEd) and Local Government Units (LGUs).
2. The contest is open to public school teachers within their respective district.
3. The contest is open to any type of act or performance such as singing, dancing, acting, etc.
4. Each interested individual or group shall coordinate with the District In-charge for the application.
5. Each district have one (1) entry may it solo or group presentation.
6. The performance will be pre-recorded and the videographer can utilize different should last for a maximum of five (5) minutes only. Two (2) points will automatically be deducted for each minute in excess of the allowed duration.
7. Contestants shall perform live in showcasing their talents on Tuesday October 5, 2021. Foreseeing possible internet connectivity interruption, the contestants are also requested to prepare a recorded video of their performances as a backup. This recorded video of their final performance for the competition must be sent to the TGT program committee in the division on October 4, 2021.
8. The video recording should be captured in a landscape orientation and must be in the file format of “.mp4” with 1080p maximum resolution.
9. The scores will be tallied at the end of the performances, and the announcement will follow shortly.
10. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a) Talent, Interpretation, and Skill-----	50%
b) Originality and Creativity -----	25%
c) Projection and Overall Impact -----	25%
Total -----	100%
11. Five (5) Winners will receive certificate of recognition and prizes, and consolation for the non-winning act, subject to the approval of the management and to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
