



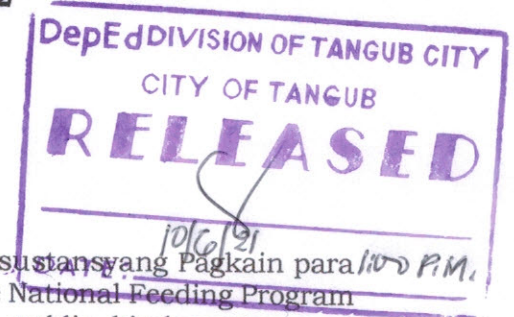

Pursuant to Republic Act 11037 also known as *Masustansyang Pagkain para sa Batang Pilipino Act*, promulgated on June 20, 2018, the National Feeding Program shall be implemented targeting all undernourished in public kindergarten and elementary schools to address undernutrition and hunger. One of the components of the National Feeding Program is the Milk Feeding Program.

2. This Office, would like to inform the schedule of delivery and pick up of Nutritious Food Product at the 5 drop off points namely, Sumirap Central School, Lorenzo Tan Memorial Central School, Tangub City Central School, Polao Integrated School and Sta. Maria Central School will start on **October 18, 2021**.



4. The School Health and Nutrition staff and Division Inspectorate team will conduct monitoring during the implementation of the said program.
