



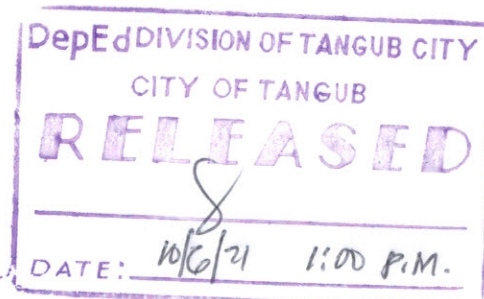




1. The current pandemic situation of COVID-19 has affected every sector of the society. Despite the limitations, the Division of Tangub City School Health and Nutrition Section is committed to continue to deliver equitable healthcare for all its clients.
2. One of the innovations that has been widely used nowadays to improve the limitation of delivering healthcare services is telemedicine. Telemedicine is the usage of digital information and communication technologies to access healthcare services remotely.
3. To provide easy access and tracking of medical records as well as to ensure the continuity of care of all its clients, the School Health and Nutrition Section is implementing the use of telemedicine thru MedCheck.
4. Effective October 6, 2021, all healthcare services/transactions that require the attention of the Division Medical Officer will be channeled thru MedCheck. These transactions include but are not limited to consultations; queries on medications, symptoms of illnesses, etc.; prescription refill; laboratory test requests; and issuance of medical certificates.
5. The School Health and Nutrition Section services are on an outpatient basis, hence all cases that require emergency medical care are advised to contact the Local Emergency Hotline or go to the nearest hospital Emergency Room.
6. Consultations done thru platforms (Facebook/Messenger/Call or SMS) other than MedCheck will not be entertained. This is to guarantee the proper monitoring of healthcare service delivery which is also reported to the Department of Education Central Office on a timely basis.





7. The MedCheck link can be accessed with any Internet browser thru the following link: <https://bit.ly/tangubclinic>. Book an appointment as a 'Patient' and ensure that Dr. Geric O. Entia is the service provider. Choose a schedule date and select a timeslot. A notification will be sent once your appointment has been set.
8. A limited face-to-face consultation or a virtual consultation will then be conducted as the School Head and Nutrition Section deem fit.
9. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this memorandum.
