- 1. DepEd mandates proper trash disposal by requiring schools to provide separate garbage cans for dry, wet, and hazardous wastes. DepEd also promotes waste management best practices at home, school, and in the community. This includes environmental protection through proper waste management, recycling waste materials using the "5S" principles, identifying recyclable products/waste materials, and disposing of waste materials in accordance with workplace safety and health regulations.
- 2. In addition, all schools ought to be reminded of the prohibited act pursuant to the provision of Article XVI, Section 43(b) of the City Ordinance NO. 2014-9-0019 entitled "Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Ordinance of Tangub City" and Chapter VI, Section 48(3) of R.A. No. 9003 entitled "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000".
- 3. As a result, the school is required to follow the law's rules in order to avoid the fines and penalties that may be imposed.
- 4. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
