

TEACHER-ADVISER TRAINING COURSE AND STUDENT LEADER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

The COVID-19 pandemic is unlikely to be the last crisis we will face in our lifetime, and probably not the first time that school leaders have been called upon to lead through times of ambiguity. Challenges faced by school leaders have ranged from rebuilding after environmental disasters to supporting communities in times of economic, social, and emotional devastation. During these times, school leaders have provided clarity and direction, built resilience, and instilled hope as they remained focused on the best possible outcomes for the student body and school communities.







