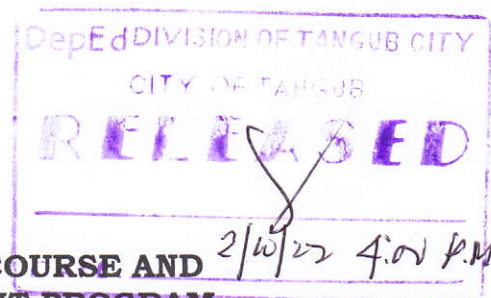

- c. Strengthen the role of teacher-advisers and student leaders in implementing programs, projects and activities (PPAs).







The COVID-19 pandemic is unlikely to be the last crisis we will face in our lifetime, and probably not the first time that school leaders have been called upon to lead through times of ambiguity. Challenges faced by school leaders have ranged from rebuilding after environmental disasters to supporting communities in times of economic, social, and emotional devastation. 




