- School heads are also expected to lead in sorting out the data below and submit them to the District In-charge for consolidation.
- a. No. of learners not participating anymore (NLPA). Quantify the reasons why they are not participating anymore.
 - b. Report of physical and financial utilization status per program.
 - c. No. of SHS graduates employed and finishers who were not employed (secondary only).
 - d. What are the issues that affect performance.
- 4. All other necessary data will be collected directly from the program holders and specific sections.
- All data must be submitted to the Division Monitoring and Evaluation Coordinator on or before March 17 for the final consolidation and preparation for the Pre-work on March 24-25, 2022.
