The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA), through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS), has been campaigning to gain advocates for mental health by increasing awareness and engaging learners in mental health-related programs.

The designated Regional Youth Formation Coordinators (RYFCs) will serve as guardians of the identified student panelists during the preparatory workshops. As guardians, they will address the concerns of the student panelist, including the facilitation and submission of confirmation slip and consent form to DRRMS on or before March 18, 2022. All confirmed student panelists are requested also to be excused in the classes that will be affected by the workshops.
