- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act 11037 also known as Masustansyang Pagkain para sa Batang Pilipino Act, promulgated on June 20, 2018, the National Feeding Program shall be implemented targeting all undernourished in public kindergarten and elementary schools to address undernutrition and hunger. One of the components of the National Feeding Program is the Milk Feeding Program.
- 2. The school-based feeding program shall run for sixteen (16) feeding days. A fresh milk shall be provided to identified learners and recipients on the SBFP- NFP for Fiscal Year 2022. Grade 6 recipients who are promoted to Grade 7 will no longer be included in the program. They will be replaced by learners who are Indigenous People (IPs), Pupils-at risk-of dropping-out (PARDOs) and indigents.

3. In this connection, the distribution will be on the following schedule
