



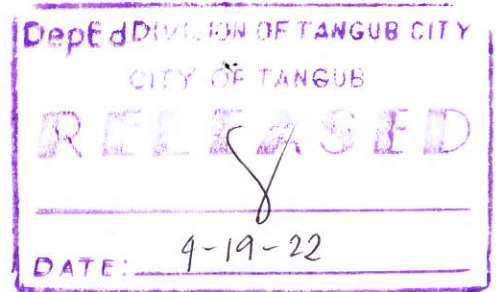



Greetings!

Acting on your request letter dated March 3, 2022 you are hereby permitted to conduct **LIMITED FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES** starting this March 28, 2022, but subject to strict adherence to the following health and safety protocols under Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, s. 2021 entitled "OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF LIMITED FACE-TO FACE LEARNING MODALITY".

- a. Only qualified schools that are recommended by the district in-charge shall be allowed to conduct limited face-to-face classes, to wit:

- b. Only fully vaccinated teaching and non-teaching personnel shall be allowed to join the conduct of limited face-to-face classes;
- c. Only fully vaccinated students shall be allowed to join limited face-to-face classes;
- d. Take additional precautionary measures, as needed, for the vulnerable individual/groups who will participate in the limited face-to-face classes;
- e. Minimum public health standards set by the DOH for these limited face-to-face classes shall be observed always;
- f. Any violation of the above-mentioned conditions shall be sufficient cause for the imposition of the appropriate penalties and for the City to order the immediate cessation of the event.
