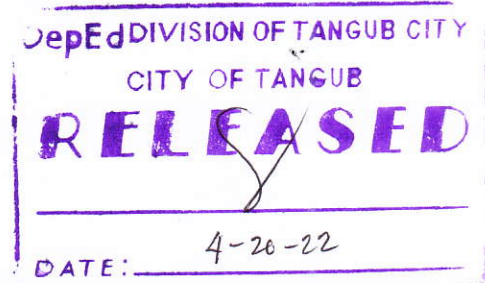

**2022 MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSES (MOOC)

1. Regarding the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) Memorandum 00-0322-0160, dated March 17, 2022, this Office will conduct the **Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WaSH) in School (WinS) Program Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs)** composed of **Leading WinS** and **Accelerating WinS**, which aim to accelerate the improvement of WaSH status in school.

2. In accordance with DepEd Order No. 014, s. 2020, the implementation of these virtual capacity building initiatives is required in meeting the minimum health standards and in ensuring that proper hygiene can be practiced by the learners and DepEd personnel in the current situation and once schools reopen at some point in the future.
