- discuss other Regional/field activities inspired by national policies and programs
- discuss the information dissemination programs and activities organized for the protection of children

The Regional Offices through the RIOs, shall screen the submissions of their respective Regions. Write-ups must be subject to quality and ethical standards.

It is requested that the Regional Offices submit a minimum of 10 articles, which shall include write-ups from learners, parents, teachers, non-teaching personnel, and officials.

The CPU will conduct the final screening and editing of the submissions. The authors of the articles that will be included for publishing will receive certificates of recognition from the Child Protection Unit.
