

- Document served as chairman of a special committee, such as curriculum study committee; committee to prepare instructional materials; committee to prepare school program and discharged the work efficiently.
- h. Initiated or headed an educational research activity duly approved by educational authorities, either for improvement of instruction, for community development or teacher welfare.
- Coordinator of community project or activity program of another agency or coordinator of a rural service improvement activity in a community such as feeding, nutrition, agro-industrial fairs, etc. for at least two years.
- Organized/managed an in-service activity or other similar activities at least on school level.
- k. Credited with meritorious achievements.
- 1. Authorship
- The documents shall be arranged accordingly to what are enumerated in the previous paragraph which includes a table of contents.
 - Each sheet must bear a page number.
 - Fastened at the top portion inside the folder while the tabbing according to the table of contents (a-i) and (a-l.) shall be at the bottom of the documents.
 - The applicants shall prepare two sets of pertinent documents following the above preparation.
 - The original copies of the documents shall be brought during the interview / deliberation.
 - Only the qualified applicants who can attend the interview / deliberation shall be included in the rank list.
- Interview for the qualified applicants will be on July 8, 2022 at exactly 8:15 o'clock in the morning via face to face at Tangub City National High School.
