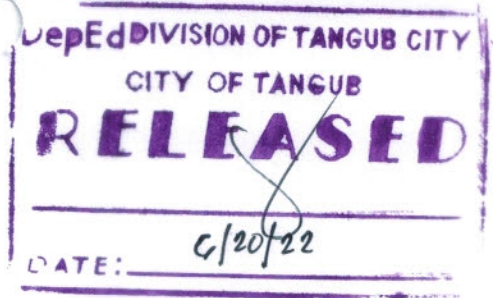

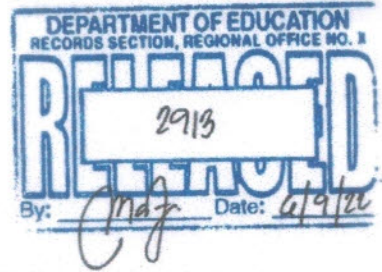

Tuberculosis (TB) remains highly prevalent in the country. In particular, it is the eighth leading cause of death among the working-age group. The infectious disease also has a significant impact on families and communities, as families become impoverished whenever a family member comes down with tuberculosis. At present, there is a continuing global effort for TB Elimination by 2030.

The virtual forum aims to present the strategic enhancements and necessary activities for the Philippines to attain the TB elimination targets, particularly during and after the COVID-19 Pandemic.
