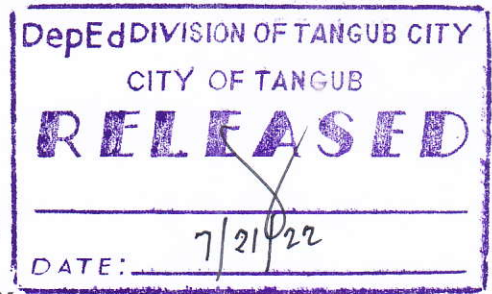



Subject: **BRIDGING THE TANGUB STARS TO READ**

- Regarding RM 414, s. 2022 on Rx ADOBE, Road to Learning Recovery Phase 1 and on the DepEd Thrust of making every child a reader at one's own grade level and the Region X's Project Care for NorMin Readers (Project CNR), the Division of Tangub City bridges the **Tangub Stars** to read.
- The activity is a 10-day evidence-based intervention that helps frustration learners catch up with their peers. It will make use of the presence of partner radio station and television, Basa-Phone Research, Basa-Tel, Home Visits, and other appropriate activities in order to deliver the reading interventions in different modalities.
- Hereunder are the indicative activities for implementation:

Date	Activity	Participants
August 5	Orientation	PSDICs, School Reading Coordinators, Reading Teachers
August 8-19	Implementation	Reading Teachers
August 16-19	Monitoring of Activities	PSDICs and EPSs
August 22-26	Feedback and Presentation of Results	All persons involved

- Service credits/compensatory time shall be granted to the Reading Teachers after evaluating the total number of hours rendered as reflected in Form 48 or Daily Time Record (DTR) during the implementation phase.
- Expenses incurred in this activity are charged to Division MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations.
