

DIVISION MEMORANDUM No. 200. s. 2022

2022 BRIGADA ESKWELA CUM BRIGADA PAGBASA KICK-OFF PROGRAM

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 34, s. 2022 titled "School Calendar and Acitivities for the SY 2022-2023," the 2022 Brigada Eskwela shall be conducted on August 1-26, 2022 in all Public Elementary and Secondary Schools with the theme "Brigada Eskwela: Tugon sa Hamon ng Ligtas na Balik-Aral."

2. This year's Brigada Eskwela shall focus on the following:

- a. implementation of the year-round school's maintenance and repair activities which include the provision of the immediate needs during disaster or calamities addressing of resource gaps during the reopening of face-to-face classes;
- engagements with partners b. strengthened partnership and stakeholders that complement DepEd's effort to ensure quality basic education:
- c. achievement of significant goals which shall contribute in increasing students' participation rate, reducing drop-outs and helping improve learning for both learners and community; and
- d. creation of a network of community-based organization to get a total community commitment for collaborative programs and projects support and other and brigada pagbasa including the volunteer/community-based projects.

In connection to this, the Division of Tangub City shall conduct the 3. 2022 Division Brigada Eskwela Cum Brigada Pagbasa Kick-Off program on August 4, 2022, at Tangub City Central School, Mantic, Tangub City. The program will start with a motorcade at 7:30 in the morning followed by an opening program at 9 o' clock in the morning. The assembly area of the motorcade is at the Division Office grounds.

Participants to this activity are the Division Office personnel, Public 4. Schools District In-Charge, Elementary and Secondary School Heads.
