

Wins READINESS ASSESSMENT FOR THE OPENING OF CLASSES 2022 AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office X, through the Education Support Services Division Health and Nutrition Section (ESSD-HNS), will conduct a **WinS Readiness Assessment for the Opening of Classes 2022 amidst the COVID-19 Pandemic** in all elementary and secondary schools on August 22 September 30.
- 2. The assessment aims to determine the status of all schools in the preparation of the opening of classes in the implementation of health protocols in accordance with DepEd Order 14, s. 2020. It is initiated to ensure that the schools have provided a healthy environment for the learners and personnel through proper hygiene and sanitation.
- 3. Hence, this Office requires all elementary and secondary schools to be assessed by the district WinS coordinators and health personnel. The district and division WinS coordinators shall consolidate the reports and send them to the Regional Office (RO), Education Support Services Division Health and Nutrition Section (ESSD-HNS), via email at hnu.regionx@deped.gov.ph on or before October 7.
- 4. This assessment is not an inspection tool or any requirement to reopen the schools. Sanitation and hygiene have always been the concern of the WinS Program even before the pandemic. Attached are the school and consolidated assessment tools.
- 5. This Office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.


