 - c) collaborate and build a strong network across different sectors to deliver real, responsive, and impactful change.
4. Tangub City Division Youth Convergence 2022 is a face-to-face activity and minimum health standards will be complied.





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5. Participants to this activity are the Supreme Pupil/Student Government (SPG/SSG) Presidents and their Teacher-Advisers.
6. School heads are enjoined to secure parental consent of their learner participant/s.

DATE : October 27, 2022

This is in reference to various requests for permission and invitations by local government units, other government agencies, external partners, and other stakeholders requesting the participation of learners and teachers in extra-curricular activities.

This Office reiterates the current situation of the basic education system in the Philippines due to the various challenges brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic. Given this, the Department of Education is focused on carrying out learning recovery measures for this school year with the resumption of full in-person classes in all public schools on November 2, 2022.

To ensure that the learning recovery initiatives of the Department will be effectively and successfully implemented, **activities that require the participation of learners and teachers that will result in the disruption of classes are strictly prohibited**, as stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 34, s. 2022, titled *School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2022-2023*.

However, activities such as, but not limited to, **academic and non-academic competitions, sports meets, and other contests, including the practices and training of such activities, shall be allowed** on the condition that they will be held outside class hours, on weekends, or during school breaks, as provided in DO No. 9, s. 2005 or *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.

Field officials are directed to **prioritize implementing learning recovery measures and focus on the full implementation of in-person classes.**

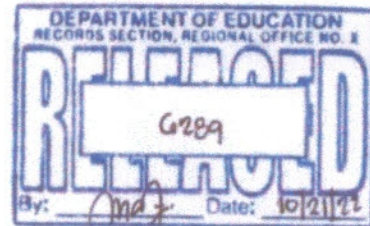

MAXIMIZATION OF CONTACT TIME IN TEACHING AND LEARNING

To: Schools Division Superintendents
 All Others Concerned

1. This issuance reiterates and emphasizes **DM No. 034, s. 2022** titled **School Calendar and Activities for SY 2022-2023**, which stipulates that "The number of school days in this DO shall solely be dedicated to academics and related co-curricular activities. **The conduct of extra-curricular activities shall be strictly prohibited.**"

2. Guided by these provisions, the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and schools must maximize their contact time in teaching and learning with emphasis on efforts toward enhancing the learners' performance in all key stages of the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC), which is low proficient (25-49) as per Rx ADOBE assessment report.

3. Hence, this Office directs the recalibrated implementation of the Rx ADOBE Learning Recovery and Continuity Plan (LRCP) and its contextualized programs in the field to close learning gaps and ensure that all schools experience a productive and continuous educational journey.

4. This Office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.
