- Regarding Regional Memoranda 697, s. 2022 and 779, s. 2022, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a Workshop with School Heads on the Intensive Progress Monitoring of Senior High School Curriculum at the Division Office Conference Hall on December 27.
- The activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Collaborate with school heads on the readiness of schools for the conduct of the National Achievement Test for Grade 12 learners:
 - b. Design strategy for school intensive monitoring of interventions;
 - c. Draft an initial plan to maximize shortened classes for enrichment sessions on SHS Learning Competencies based on the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs); and
 - d. Submit a schedule of the Intensive Enrichment Classes for monitoring purposes.
- Participants of this activity are the school heads of SHS with Grade 12 learners. They are advised to take with them their laptops and extension wires.
- All expenses relative to the participation of this activity shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
