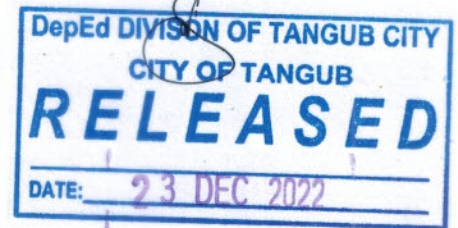



**WORKSHOP WITH SCHOOL HEADS ON THE INTENSIVE
PROGRESS MONITORING OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM**

1. Regarding Regional Memoranda 697, s. 2022 and 779, s. 2022, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a Workshop with School Heads on the Intensive Progress Monitoring of Senior High School Curriculum at the Division Office Conference Hall on December 27.
2. The activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Collaborate with school heads on the readiness of schools for the conduct of the National Achievement Test for Grade 12 learners;
 - b. Design strategy for school intensive monitoring of interventions;
 - c. Draft an initial plan to maximize shortened classes for enrichment sessions on SHS Learning Competencies based on the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs); and
 - d. Submit a schedule of the Intensive Enrichment Classes for monitoring purposes.
3. Participants of this activity are the school heads of SHS with Grade 12 learners. They are advised to take with them their laptops and extension wires.
4. All expenses relative to the participation of this activity shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
5. This Office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.
