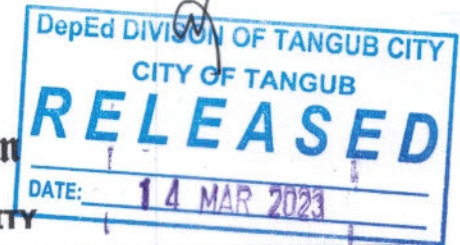

- Does the poster demonstrate creativity and originality?

3. Aesthetic Appeal (30%)

- Does the poster design captivate the judge's sense, considering the principle of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality, and proportion?
