In compliance with DepEd Order (DO) No. 8, s. 2013 this Office issued this advisory not for endorsement per DO 28, s. 2001, but only for the information of DepEd officials, personnel/staff, as well as the concerned public

AN ORDER ALLOWING THE CONDUCT OF IN-PERSON ACTIVITIES IN SCHOOLS

DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2023 was issued for the guidance of learners, personnel, parent, guardian, and other stakeholders relative to the conduct of inperson school activities. For safety resumption and reintroduction of the conduct of inperson school activities, consistent with the public health standards of the government in line with COVID-19, the following guidelines shall be observed:

a. Curricular and co-curricular activities that involve the in-person gathering of several participants shall be allowed. Curricular activities shall be conducted during the academic quarter to ensure that learners can seamlessly connect and integrate learning within and across learning areas. On the other hand, co-curricular activities shall be conducted after the quarterly examinations to avoid disruption of classes.

b. Item 33 of DepEd Order no,034, s. 2022 dated July 11, 2022, provides that; The conduct of extracurricular activities shall be strictly prohibited. However, it must be clarified that only those **extracurricular activities held during class hours are prohibited.** The conduct of in-person extracurricular activities shall be allowed provided that these activities are conducted after class hours.

Public Schools must ensure the strict observance of these guidelines during the conduct of in-person curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities.

The Private schools, and community learning centers, may choose to adopt the provisions of this DepEd Order as a basis for the conduct of in-person curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities.

Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Advisory is directed.

AN ORDER ALLOWING THE CONDUCT OF IN-PERSON ACTIVITIES IN SCHOOLS

Undersecretaries Assistant Secretaries Bureau and Service Directors Regional Directors Minister, Basic, Higher and Technical Education, BARMM Schools Division Superintendents Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads State/Local University and College Heads All Others Concerned

- In line with the commitment of the Department of Education (DepEd) to deliver quality basic education in a safe learning environment to learners, this Order is issued for the guidance of learners, personnel, parents, guardians, and other stakeholders relative to the conduct of in-person school activities.
- For the safe resumption and reintroduction of the conduct of in-person school activities, consistent with the public health standards of the government in light of COVID-19, the following guidelines shall be observed:
 - a. Curricular and co-curricular activities that involve the in-person gathering of a number of participants shall be allowed. Curricular activities shall be conducted during the academic quarter to ensure that learners can seamlessly connect and integrate learning within and across learning areas. On the other hand, co-curricular activities shall be conducted after the quarterly examinations to avoid disruption of classes.
 - b. Item 33 of DepEd Order No. 034, s. 2022 dated July 11, 2022, provides that: The conduct of extra-curricular activities shall be strictly prohibited. However, it must be clarified that only those extracurricular activities held during class hours are prohibited. The conduct of in-person extra-curricular activities shall be allowed, provided that these activities are conducted after class hours.
- Public Schools must ensure the strict observance of these guidelines during the conduct of in-person curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities.
- Private schools, community learning centers, as well as state/local universities and colleges (SUCs/LUCs) may choose to adopt the provisions of this DO as basis in the conduct of in-person curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities.

- 5. This Order shall take effect upon posting on the DepEd website. It shall also be filed with the University of the Philippines Law Center (UP LC)-Office of the National Administrative Register (ONAR), UP Diliman, Quezon City.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Order is directed.
