 - show unity and strength during the challenging times.
- 3. All schools are advised to implement the activities as stipulated in item number 4 of the said memorandum, discussions in the classroom on Philippine flag awareness and significant events in history that led to the Proclamation of Philippine Independence will be on Friday, June 9, 2023.
- 4. The Education Program Supervisor in Araling Panlipunan shall lead in ensuring that all activities will be implemented in the schools division.
- 5. A comprehensive report of the activities shall be submitted to the Division Office on or before June 30, 2023. The report should include a summary of the activities conducted, participation statistics, and visual documentation.



- The Department of Education (DepEd) will participate in the commemoration of 1. the 125th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence with the theme, Kalayaan. Kinabukasan. Kasaysayan from May 28 to June 30, 2023. This is in accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 110, s. 1963, titled Declaring June 12 as Philippine Independence Day, and Administrative Order No. 23, s. 2011, titled Creating a Steering Committee on National Observances. All departments, bureaus, offices, government agencies, and government-owned and controlled corporations are required to give full support, assistance, and cooperation to the National Steering Committee (NSC). chaired by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), in the exercise of its responsibilities and functions in order to achieve the celebration's objectives.
- 2. This year's celebration aims to

commemorate the heroism, patriotism, nationalism, and self-sacrifice of our Filipino forefathers in the struggle for independence;

instill in the hearts and minds of the youth the greatness of the b. Filipino race, the legacy of their national heroes, and the ideals of their nationhood: and

show unity and strength during challenging times.

- The exhibit on Pampamahalaang Programa at Serbisyo, an activity that will showcase the programs and services of various government offices, will be held on June 11-12, 2023 (Sunday and Monday), from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Rizal Park, Roxas Boulevard, Manila. The following DepEd offices are invited to participate:
 - Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), a.

Public Affairs Service (PAS), h

Administrative Service (General Services Division),

External Partnerships Service-Special Events Unit (EPS-SEU)-National Technical Working Group (TWG/Coordinator), and

DepEd National Capital Region (NCR).

To commemorate the 125th Anniversary of Philippine Independence and to observe the National Flag Day, the DepEd central office (CO), regional offices (RO), schools division offices (SDO), and schools are required to undertake the following activities:

- a. Simultaneous Flag Raising in schools or historical sites on June 12, 2023:
- Display of the Philippine Flag in the classrooms (charged to the School's MOOE), offices, and residences of all teaching and nonteaching personnel from May 15 to June 30, 2023;
- c. Discussions on the Philippine flag awareness and significant events in history, which led to the Proclamation of Philippine Independence especially in Sibika at Kultura, Heograpiya, Kasaysayan at Sining (HEKASI), Araling Panlipunan, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP), Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH), Filipino and English, at least once a week for the whole year;
- d. Submission of school work related to the celebration of Independence Day. Grades 1 to 3 learners will submit a drawing of the Philippine Flag, while higher grade levels will submit a one-page reflection paper on what they did during Independence Day or share experiences on what the Philippine Independence means to them, to be collected by their teachers;
- c. Conduct of symposium and/or round table discussion to raise awareness on the event, and propagate values like nationalism, patriotism, and love of country, which were exhibited by the Filipinos during the trying periods of the country;
- f. Putting up a bulletin board or a venue within the campus where informative materials concerning the commemorative event may be displayed;
- g. A month-long sharing of insights on the same topic is encouraged during the flag ceremony at the ROs, SDOs, and schools to be spearheaded by the Araling Panlipunan Supervisors; and
- h. Other creative and fitting activities.
- 5. All DepEd officials, teachers, and learners at the national, regional, schools division, and school levels are required to actively participate in the scheduled activities.
- 6. DepEd requests the support, assistance, and cooperation of the regions stated in the enclosure for the Simultaneous Flag Raising and Wreath-laying Ceremonies on **June 12, 2023, 8:00 a.m.** at various historical sites and venues.
- 7. Teachers shall receive appropriate service credits as stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 53, s. 2003, titled **Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers**, and DO 84, s. 2003, titled **Addendum to DO No. 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers)**, while nonteaching personnel should attend programs and activities on **official time only**.
- 8. Travel expenses (transportation and per diem) of the TWG, meals, communication, documentation, supplies, carpentry materials, preparatory, and other incidental expenses from May 28 to June 30, 2023, shall be charged to the 2023 Building Partnership and Linkages Program, whereas exhibitors' travel expenses from various DepEd offices and participating schools, and the materials production of flyers, tarpaulins, and other materials shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
