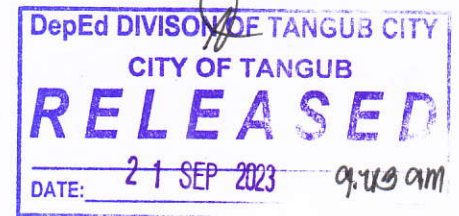

1. The Schools Division Office (SDO) ensures the promotion of equity in access and continuously improves the quality of basic education with the following expected outcomes;

- a. Schools and learning centers implement the curriculum that is compliant to the quality standards for basic education;
- b. Schools and learning centers can ensure a child-friendly and healthy working environment;
- c. Public and private schools and learning centers are recognized/recommended/given permit to operate;
- d. All interested parties are equitably and equally provided with administrative, financial, and legal services; and
- e. Schools and learning centers efficiently utilize funds provided by the national government, local government units, and other education stakeholders and/or development partners.

2. As stipulated in number 4 of DepED Order No. 22, s. 2023 entitled *Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year (SY) 2023- 2024*, "Private schools and state/local universities and colleges may adopt these omnibus implementing guidelines on the school calendar and shall follow the provisions stipulated under RA 11480 concerning the required number of class days and the opening of the SY. Schools shall report any inevitable deviation from these guidelines in advance to their respective regional offices (ROs)".




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3. The said conference emphasized the importance of the following:
