Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242 which formally declared the period of 05 September to 05 October of every year as *National Teacher's Month*, and Republic Act No. 10743- an act declaring the 5th of October as *National Teacher's Day*, this Office shall conduct a **Teacher's Day Program** on October 3, 2023, 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM at the People's Gym, Tangub City, with the theme: **Together 4 Teachers**, where 4 represents the 4As of gratitude: appreciation, admiration, approval, and attention.
