

## CONDUCT OF DIVISION CONSUMER QUIZ BOWL

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors (CID and SGOD) Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District In-Charge (PSDICs) Elementary and Secondary School Heads Private Schools All Others Concerned This Division

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 1098 which is created under Republic Act 7394, otherwise known as the "Consumer Act of the Philippine", October of every year is declared as the Consumer Welfare Month (CWN), with the year celebration theme "GenS: Generation Sustainable," this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the Division Quiz Bowl at 2p.m. on Wednesday September 27, 2023 at Tangub City Central School Conference Hall.

2. The Division Level Consumer Quiz Bowl is part of the Department of Trade and Industry's consumer education program. Its primary goal is to raise the level of awareness and understanding of youth on various aspects related to consumer protection and welfare. This includes standards, prices, monitoring and enforcement activities, product quality and safety characteristics, trade and industry news, and other consumer-related issues.

3. All public and private secondary schools within the division will send 1 contestant who is presently a Grade 9 or Grade 10 student. Participating school must register via google sheet link: <u>https://bit.ly/Division\_QuizBowl2023</u>

4. Each participating school is required to submit at least 2 questions for each category with answer key to be submitted during the quiz proper. These questions should cover the following categories: easy, average, and difficult. The content of the questions should be based on the Consumer Act of the Philippines (RA 7394), Price Act (7581), Fair Trade Laws, and other consumer-related laws and policies of the Department of Trade and Industry.

5. The 6 winners for this event will compete in the Provincial Level on October 6, 2023 at 1:30p.m. at Oroquieta City.

6. All secondary schools are encouraged to actively participate in this educational and engaging event. It offers a valuable opportunity for students to learn about their rights and responsibilities as consumers and to contribute to the promotion of a sustainable and consumer-friendly environment.



## **PROVINCIAL CONSUMER QUIZ 2023** Guidelines

- 01. The contest is open to all public and private Grade 9 or Grade 10 level students.
- 02. Each division is allowed with maximum of six (6) contestants/representatives only.
- 03. Contestants should wear their complete school uniform during the contest for easy identification.
- 04. The contents of the questions are based on the Consumer Act of the Philippines (RA 7394), Price Act (RA 7581), Fair Trade Laws, and other Consumer related laws and policies of the Department of Trade & Industry.
- 05. Contestants are provided with white board, pen and eraser for their use during the contest.
- 06. English is the official language in the conduct of the questions.
- 07. There will be twenty-five (25) questions to be given, ten (10) of which are easy questions, ten (10) questions are average and the other five (5) questions are difficult.
- 08. Points given to every correct answer are as follows:
  - a. One (1) point for easy question

  - b. Two (2) points for average question
    c. Three (3) points for difficult question
- 09. Each question is to be read twice by the Quiz Master. Countdown starts after the question has been read for the second time.
- 10. Each question is given ten (10) seconds to answer.
- 11. A contestant is allowed to change/erase the answer within the allotted time of the question.
- 12. Wrong spelling wrong.
- 13. The winners will be proclaimed based on cumulative scoring system.
- 14. In case of tie, there will be a set of tie breaking questions for those concerned contestants.
- 15. There will be three (3) judges to score the answers.
- 16. There will be three (3) winners and they will be qualified to join the Regional **Consumer Quiz Bowl.**
- 17. Protest or inquiry should be addressed orally to the chair of the Board of Judges and the decision of the Board is final.
- 18. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners.

1st Place - Php5,000.00 2<sup>nd</sup> Place - Php3,000.00 3rd Place - Php2.000.00

19. Deadline for submission of the list of participants is on October 2, 2023.
