All learning area supervisors shall mobilize their team of writers and make use of the Least Mastered Skills in the learning areas and grade levels, as determined in the results of the Diagnostic Assessment. - 4. The soft copy of the test materials shall be submitted to EPS Gina L. Mandawe, LRMDS in charge, fifteen (15) working days before the schedule of the test, to provide ample time for printing and reproduction.
- 5. All expenses in the conduct of this activity shall be charged against the school MOOE, local funds and any other source of funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
