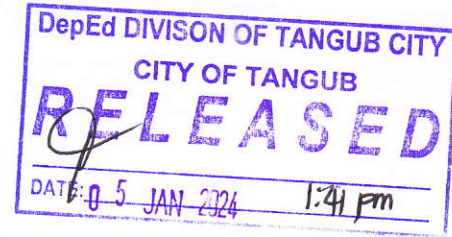

MONDAY AS FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT DAY

1. In response to the challenging results of assessment based on the presentation of the PISA 2022 national report highlighting the dismal performance of learners in Reading, Mathematics, and Science, this Division through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall implement a scheme in the giving of formative assessment in all learning areas.
2. This scheme is dubbed as **Monday: A Formative Assessment Day** which shall be applied in all learning areas and grade levels, **effective immediately**.
3. The formative assessment shall provide an opportunity to monitor the learning acquired by the class and to provide ongoing feedback which can be used by the teachers to design and/or redesign the learning instructions and delivery, appropriate to the needs of learners.
4. All instructional leaders and teachers shall employ the Structure of Observed Learning Outcome (SOLO) framework and Bloom's Taxonomy in designing the assessment activities and not limited to reading activities for the learners to develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
5. The Learning Action Cell (LAC) in all schools shall be strengthened to focus on designing assessments and preparing the learners in answering different types of tests.
6. All schools are encouraged to work on innovations, initiatives, and research that relate to this cause and mandate.
7. This Office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.
