

The Department of Education (DepEd) issued DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017 titled Research Management Guidelines and DepEd Order No. 26, s. 2021 titled Amendment to DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017 (Research Management Guidelines) to promote and strengthen the culture of research in basic education continuously. Hence, this Office announces the Call for Research Proposals under the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF).
- 2. The proponents must submit the following in three hard copies:
 - a. Application Form and Endorsement of Immediate Supervisor of the Proponent (Annex 1),
 - b. Research Proposal (Annex 2), and
 - c. Anti-plagiarism and Absence of Conflict of Interest Declaration (Annex 3).
- 3. School-based research proposals, with the summary list, shall be submitted to and evaluated by the Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC) in the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and shall be forwarded to the Regional Research Committee (RRC).
- 4. District, divisional, regional, and national level research proposals shall be sent to the RRC of the Regional Office (RO).
- 5. The research papers must be based on **DO 39**, **s. 2016** on the Adoption of the Basic Education Research Agenda within the context of the Region and consider the report of the School Monitoring, Evaluation, and Adjustment (SMEA) and program implementation review of the programs and activities.
- 6. Further, the research must cover all learning areas to address issues and gaps in improving learning outcomes.
