**TREE PLANTING ACTIVITY FOR ALL GRADUATING LEARNERS**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent (ASDS)  
 Chief Education Program Supervisors (CID & SGOD)  
 Education Program Supervisors (EPSs)  
 Public Schools District In-Charge (PSDICs)  
 All Others Concerned

- As regards DepEd Order No. 033, s. 2008 re Responding to the Threats of Climate Change and Global Warming Through Massive, Intensive and Sustained Tree-Planting, Tree-Growing and Tree-Caring Program, this Office shall implement the Tree Planting Activity for All Graduating Learners.
- The activity is also in support to DepEd Memorandum No. 069, s. 2023 titled Guidelines on the Implementation of the Project – “DepEd’s 236,000 Trees – A Christmas Gift for the children.”
- All elementary and secondary graduating learners are required to **plant one tree within the school vicinity on or before graduation**. These trees shall be fruit bearing, Philippine native species, or mangroves.
- Schools shall designate a team to manage the activity which includes the acquisition of seedlings, the identification of areas to be planted, and the preparation of the tree-planting tools and tree guards. Each tree planted shall be with a tree guard with attached 4” x 8” plywood-nameplate bearing the name of the learner.
- All schools are advised to document the activity and submit a pictorial narrative Accomplishment Report, Attention: Curriculum Implementation Division (CID).
- This Office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.
