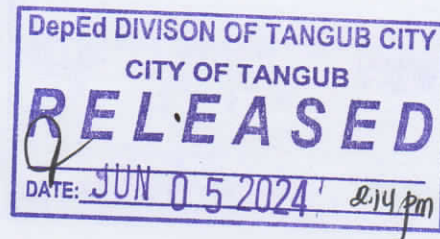

CONDUCT OF ALS COMMUNITY LITERACY MAPPING AND ENROLMENT

1. One of the Division-Initiated Projects (DIP) is Project REACH (Revitalizing Education for ALS Learners in their Community and in their Home) which is to strengthen access to Out-of-School Youths and adults in the community.
2. In this connection, the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) through the Alternative Learning System (ALS) shall conduct Community Literacy Mapping and Enrolment for the School Year 2024-2025 on June 3 to July 26.
3. The objectives of this activity are the following:
 - Ensure all Out-of-School Youths and adults in the community will be identified and registered;
 - Improve services, expand community support and solve education problems, often by bringing groups together to act at a community level; and
 - Seek to understand the barriers to have access to education and the possible local solutions or interventions that will bring OSYs and adults back to learning centers and will ensure their completion of basic Kto12 education.
4. Community ALS Implementers are directed to conduct various activities like house-to-house campaign, posting announcement, meetings with local and barangay officials and civic organizations, and other advocacy activities immediately.
5. Moreover, ALS Teachers will do the same activity effective July 1.
6. Participants of this activity are ALS Teachers and Community ALS Implementers.
