PARTICIPATION TO THE 126TH CELEBRATION OF THE PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE DAY

- 1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 374, May 28 is declared as National Flag Day to honor the 1898 victory of Filipino forces at the Battle of Alapan in Imus, Cavite. Executive Order No. 179, mandates the prominent display of the Philippine National Flag in all buildings, establishments, and homes across the Philippines from May 28 to June 12 each year. This period is designated to promote patriotism and to commemorate the first unfurling of the Philippine Flag in 1898.
- 2. To support the aforementioned celebration, this Office, directs all elementary and secondary schools to display the Philippine National Flag prominently within the school premises and in homes where it is visible from May 28 to June 12, 2024. This display is essential to reinforce the values of patriotism and national pride among students and the community.
- 3. All are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the rules regarding the proper handling and display of the Philippine National Flag. Information from DepEd Philippines Facebook post dated May 28, 2024 is attached to this Memorandum.
- 4. In observance of Independence Day on June 12, 2024, everyone is highly encouraged to participate in the city's celebration in collaboration with the local government unit. This participation is vital to honor the spirit of independence and foster a sense of community engagement.
- 5. A Narrative Accomplishment Report of activities shall be submitted to the Division Office on or before June 30, 2024. The report should include a summary of the activities conducted, participation statistics, and visual documentation.
