- 1.Relative to Division Memorandum No. 118 S. 2024 entitled "Utilization of Multi-Factored Assessment Tool (MFAT) and Adoption of Transition Curriculum for Learners with Special Needs in Education (SNEd) to Untrained Grade- I Teachers and Receiving Teachers", all schools are hereby informed of the change of participants from untrained grade-1 teachers and receiving teachers to school administrators both in the elementary and secondary schools, to be held at the Tangub City Division Conference Room, Tangub City on June 22, 2024.
