**ENSURING THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELL-BEING OF LEARNERS DURING
THE CONDUCT OF NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP**

1. In line with the Department of Education (DepEd) commitment to ensuring a safe and conducive learning environment for all learners and articulated in the MATATAG Agenda to “Take good care of learners by promoting learner well-being, inclusive education, and a positive learning environment,” this Office directs all the school heads to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of the learners and teachers during the conduct of National Learning Camp (NLC).
2. Below are the indicators to observe in managing school operations, particularly on safety measures:
 - a. Each camp must have a designated safety officer and an emergency plan in place. Emergency contacts be prominently displayed.
 - b. A well-stocked first aid kit must be readily available. At least one staff member trained in first aid should be present at the camp.
 - c. Established safe entrance and exit, and crowd management measures for teachers, students, non-teaching personnel, and school visitors.
 - d. Set up clear and easy-to-understand safety warning signages on pedestrian lane markings/humps, loading/unloading signs, stop and go signs, signs for the physically impaired, and signages on the observance of health protocols and protective measures.
3. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Division Memorandum is desired.
