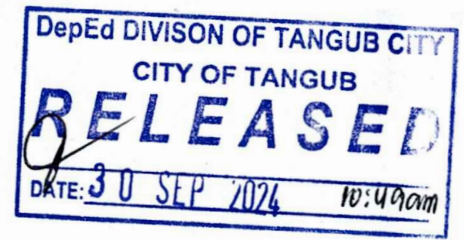

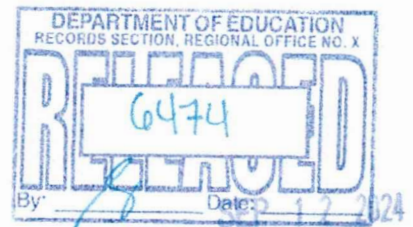

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) acknowledges and upholds the inherent rights of every child, which are essential to their overall well-being and development. This commitment is firmly rooted in the conviction that all students are entitled to an educational environment that is not only secure but also supportive, inclusive, and conducive to their academic advancement and personal growth.
2. Hence, this Office, through the Education Support Service Division- Learner Rights Protection Office (ESSD-LRPO) will conduct the **Regional Orientation to Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) Policy Vis-À-Vis Training-Workshop for Strengthened Child Protection Committee (CPC) Functionality** in Cagayan de Oro City, on October 2-4.
3. This activity aims to improve the efficiency among relevant focal persons and committee members in handling child protection issues and implementing the Learner Rights Protection Policy effectively.
4. The participants of this activity will be the **Division LRP focal persons** (two for each division), **Registered Guidance Counselors or Designates** (three for each division), **School Heads** (three for each division), and **Mental Health Care providers** who are preferably trained with Psychological First Aid (one for each division), and the Regional Technical Working Group (RTWG).
5. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall submit the official names of their participants through this link: <https://rb.gy/5emfw6> on or before **September 13**.
6. The final venue and the official names of the participants will be announced through a separate memorandum to be issued by this Office.
7. The participants' meals and accommodation shall be charged to the LRP Program Support Funds (PSF) while their travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged to their local/MOOE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
