**SUSPENSION OF CLASSES AT ALL LEVEL AND SHIFTING TO  
ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE AND BLENDED LEARNING DUE TO  
TYPHOON KRISTINE**

1. In adherence to the Executive Order No. 159, s. 2024 "An Order Declaring the Suspension of Classes in All Levels in Both Public and Private Schools in Tangub City, this Office informs that afternoon classes in all levels in both public and private schools are hereby suspended today 25 October 2024.
2. All schools are advised to shift to alternative delivery modes (ADM) to ensure learning continuity, this measure was the subject of OASOPS No. 2023-077 issued last 20 April 2023, and OUCT and OUOPS Memorandum dated 28 February 2023 (Implementation of Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) in All Public Elementary and Secondary Schools).
3. Public Schools District Supervisors and School Heads are tasked to implement Catch-up Plans to keep the teachers and learners engaged during class suspensions. Attached is the template to be used.
4. Public Schools District Supervisors shall consolidate the school reports to be submitted to the Division DRRM Coordinator.

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 159,  
Series of 2024**

**AN ORDER DECLARING THE SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN  
ALL LEVELS IN BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN  
TANGUB CITY**

**WHEREAS**, Article II, Section 14 of the Constitution provides that the State Shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure an promote health and safety and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, it is expected that due to tropical storm "Kristine, heavy rainfall, strong winds and rain-induced landslides or floods may likely occur in area that are highly susceptible to these hazards;

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Tangub is bound to protect all the residents from impending disasters;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, SABINIANO S. CANAMA**, City Mayor of Tangub City, Misamis Occidental, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the following:

**SECTION 1. Declaration.** Afternoon classes in all levels in both public and private schools is hereby suspended today **25 October 2024** in the City of Tangub.

**SECTION 2.** The City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) and City Health Office personnel shall be on standby for any public emergency and assistance services if needed.

**SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
