1. Relative to the Proclamation No. 479 s. 1994 declaring the month of November every year as FILIPINO VALUES MONTH, this Office informs the field on the schedule of activities for the whole month of November.
2. This activity aims to strengthen the moral resources of the Filipino rooted in Filipino culture, values and ideals that are pro-God, pro-people, and pro-country.
3. Below are the activities to be conducted in the Edukasyon Sa Pagpapakatao (ESP)/GMRC class and integrated in all learning areas for the whole month of November.

Week 4	Poster and Slogan	School Level	Top 3 Winners in each year level.	To be conducted by the Values/GMRC teacher during their agreed time.





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4. Attached is the guidelines and mechanics for the month-long celebration.

4.1. There will be 3 categories and 3 different champions of each contest.

Category A – Elementary Level

Category B – Junior High School

Category C – Senior High School

a. **Quiz Bee** – each section will select the top 3 winners and will represent their section in the year level contest. The top two (2) winners in each year level will qualify for the final round in the school level contest. Top 3 winners will be declared in each school category. (The ESP/GMRC teacher/s will agree among themselves in the preparations of the questions and the conduct of the contest.

b. **Role Play** – each section will select one (1) winner and will represent their section in the year level contest. The champion in each year level will qualify for the final round in the school level contest. Top 3 winners will be declared in each school category. (The ESP/GMRC teacher/s will agree among themselves in the preparations of the criteria/rubrics of the role play and the conduct of the contest.

c. **Poster and Slogan Contest:**

c.1. Each section will select one (1) winning entry and will represent their section in the year level contest. The champion in each year level will qualify for the final round in the school level contest. Top 3 winners will be declared in each school category.

c.2. Materials that will be used by the contestant will be
(a.) 1 whole size white Cartolina,
(b.) pencil,
(c.) Coloring tools such as oil pastels, markers, ink, oil, acrylic, and water color.

c.3. Create your own slogan and poster inspired by pro-God, pro-people, and pro-country.

c.4. You may write it in ENGLISH or FILIPINO.

c.5. Originality must be observe. DO NOT PLAGIARIZE.
