

42^{ad} MOST OUTSTANDING PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS AWARD (MOPSTA)

 The search is open to public classroom teachers of the elementary and high school levels who have been teaching for at least 3 successive years with good moral standing and without administrative charges. The coverage areas shall be from all Divisions in Region X.

2. All interested and qualified teachers shall submit their entries through their respective School Division Office that will endorse them to the DEPED Regional Office not later than December 31, 2024. At the regional level, the MOPSTA Committee of the Rotary Club of West Cagayan de Oro together with the DEPED Regional Office will compose the selection panel who will determine the finalists. Finalists shall undergo an interview and actual teaching demonstration.

3. The selection process will be based only on the following criteria:

 Personal qualities and character
 3%

 Instructional competence and Teaching Effectiveness
 47%

 Community Involvement
 3%

 Demonstration (Classroom visit)
 25%

 Teacher-Student Involvement (after school)
 2%

 Interview of Finalists
 20%

 TOTAL
 100%

 Full application requirements and selection criteria are available at the School Division Office and DEPED Region X. Application with supporting documents must be submitted to DEPED Regional Office by January 31, 2025.

Final phase of selection and interview of finalists will be done in March 2025. The Rotary Club of West CDO together with DEPED Regional Office will announce the winners only during the awarding ceremonies.

- All participating public school teachers shall be given certificate of recognition during the awarding ceremony. Awardees will receive cash incentives and trophies. Schools where the awrdees come from will also receive cash incentives.
- Outstanding teachers who are previous winners of similar searches conducted by Metrobank and MOPSTA previous top winners are no longer qualified to join this year's search.
- Prizes, trophies and other incentives will be provided by the heirs fo the late Cagayan de Oro City Mayor Justiniano R. Borja through the Gigi Borja Endowment Fund and other generous donors who continuously support this search.
