CONDUCT OF ALS COMMUNITY LITERACY MAPPING, ADVOCACY & SOCIAL MOBILIZATION (AdSocMob) AND ENROLMENT

1. One of the Division-Initiated Projects (DIP) is Project REACH (Revitalizing Education for ALS Learners in their Community and in their Home) which is to strengthen access to Out-of-School Youths and adults in the community.

2. In this connection, the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) through the Alternative Learning System (ALS) shall conduct Community Literacy Mapping and Enrolment for the School Year 2025-2026 every second and fourth Friday of the month.
