

FIRE PREVENTION MONTH PREPARATIONS AND DISSEMINATION OF IEC MATERIALS ON FIRE SAFETY AWARENESS

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation 115-A declaring the month of March as Fire Prevention Month, all schools under this division are directed to actively participate in fire prevention initiatives and ensure dissemination of Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) materials on fire safety through the Continuing Fire Safety Awareness Program. This program was launched in schools through DepEd Order No. 72, s. 2012, to promote and intensify fire safety awareness, prevention, and preparedness among schools, personnel, staff, and learners nationwide.
2. In line with this, all schools are instructed to conduct fire safety awareness activities such as organizing school-wide fire drills in coordination with the Bureau of Fire and Protection (BFP) and local emergency response units, facilitate discussions, symposia, or orientations on fire prevention and emergency preparedness and integrate fire safety education in classroom discussions and school program.
3. Proper documentation and post-activity evaluation of fire drill are required. The school shall submit the narrative report with pictures including the total number of learners and personnel by gender **not later than April 3, 2025**, via email at mohamad.batingolo@deped.gov.ph.
4. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Division Memorandum is desired.

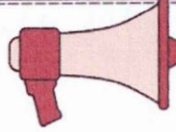

COMMON VIOLATIONS OF SCHOOLS REPORTED BY THE BFP AS FOLLOWS:



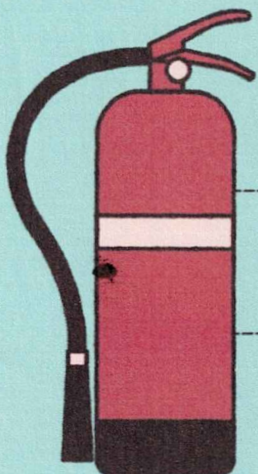
- Hazardous electrical wirings due to over usage, deterioration, and substandard installations;
- Lack of markings for emergency exits, and the blockage of these exits with unused furniture, among others;
- Absence of fire sprinkles, lack of fire fighting equipment/fire extinguishers, irregular servicing or non-maintenance of existing fire extinguishers that do not comply with ISO 9001-2008 series certified as preferably required to ensure the use of quality and non-ozone depleting products;
- Inadequate provisions of equipment/appliances via octopus outlet and other inappropriate extension; and
- Non-organization of fire brigades and lack of preparedness for fire emergencies.

Enables swift and organized evacuation during real emergencies, potentially saving lives.

Identifies areas for improvement and helps schools enhance their emergency response plans.
